Program benefits

The BSBA completion pathway offers you the opportunity to earn an affordable undergraduate business degree from a NECHE-accredited US university. You can transfer up to 90 credits you have earned at your community college.

- The degree requires a total of 121 credits, so if you transfer the maximum number of credits (90), you could earn your Bachelor's degree in less than two years.
- Both need-based financial aid and merit-based scholarships are available.
- Affordable tuition fees
- Option to take classes at our Athens campus in Greece
- Tuition fees are about the same as what an in-state student now pays at a community college.
- The program features an engaging mix of classes, most with options for either online or on-campus study
